

Great Taste Judges' Comments



Raw Dazzle: An attractive dry leaf and stalk, which soften nicely on infusion. The smokiness of the dried leaf is swiftly conveyed to the golden-yellow infusion - good clarity, though with a little dust transmitted to the cup. Pre-rinsing the leaves has ensured the absence of any potentially 'muddy' character and a 30-second infusion yielded a smokey, nutty infusion with some tropical floral-almost-fruit character. The gentle bitterness is well modulated, and tannins are light. This Pu'er has a relatively youthful feel, with more spicy grip than softness to the mouthfeel, but is beautifully balanced, nicely structured, with a satisfying firmness (more spicy than astringent) on the finish.



Jasmine Envy: Beautiful tippy leaf yields a lovely golden liquor with rounded jasmine notes. We enjoyed finding the blossoms within the tea.
